CHAPTER 10--Project Procedures

Section 1: Use of Professional Engineer Stamps on Construction Drawings

Guideline No. 10.1 (99-20)

Supersedes: G 10.1 (93-6), G 10.1 (86-9), Use of Professional Engineer Stamps on Construction Drawings

Distribution: Standard List

1. The plans should be stamped prior to their formal submittal for review to the operating utility designated to receive the facilities (usually NTUA).
2. It is up to the District Engineer to decide who shall be stamping the plans or whether more than one stamp shall be on the plans. The possible choices are the Project Engineer and/or the District Engineer.
3. Only the cover sheet of the proposed construction drawings should be stamped. Individual sheets of the drawings set should not be stamped as these stamps may be confusing when the individual sheets are included in the composite drawings of systems.
4. See Guideline 10.8 for additional instruction on plan development and review.
